Sheepy the slightly sarcastic straight talking animated sheep, narrated by comedian Rick Mercer, returns with a new message about Climate Change:

The *Changing Climate Show* leads the audience on an exploration of the ongoing effects of climate change on human and natural habitats, and looks for ways humans can meet these changes with creative and innovative ideas.



The Story

Sheepy and his friends have a problem. Their pasture is drying up and they need a plan. To aid in their fight against climate change, Sheepy and his friends have created the Fleece-Net, a global network of woolly ungulates, which allows them to benefit from the perspective and wisdom of other sheep around the world.

Alternating between global anecdotes and the hard science of climate change, Sheepy arrives at both a plan and an insight:

*“The ideas may come from everywhere,
but the solutions to climate change will be local,
because the effects of climate change
will be different everywhere.
There is no one size fits all way to adapt
to climate change.”*
