(SUDBURY, ON) – On Saturday, February 25, Science North's annual fundraising event, The Bluecoat Ball presented by Technica Mining, took place for the first time in-person since 2020. The evening was a sold-out experience and generated \$300,000 for the *Science For All* Fund. Surpassing the night's goal of \$100,000 would not have been possible without the generosity of everyone who attended the gala. Science North extends its gratitude, especially to the Bluecoat Ball Honorary Chair, Keith Brewster who concluded the event by donating \$125,000 towards the final total, supporting the *Science For All* Fund.

Science for All ensures programs related to STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) are attainable to anyone living in Sudbury and across Northern Ontario.

Visiting a land lost to time, guests will rediscover these life-sized dinos as they come to LIFE.
